### **From the Rector:**

Looking to the future:

It's the week after the annual meeting and all is well! I've heard horror stories about annual meetings. I've heard how contentious they can be, how long they can go on and how hurt people can be after such meetings. I'm pleased to say that I have never once experienced such a meeting at any parish when I have been the rector. The sharing of Fr. Jack Kilby, outgoing Senior Warden Nancy Ponec, as well as Lance Baker, were powerful and added to the positive atmosphere of the meeting.

As I relayed in my sermon on Sunday, I am not retiring. I brought this up because I've heard that it's been asked by some. I would rather deal with this head on rather than have it float in the background. It's true, someday I will retire, but not yet. I am not looking at any other positions and Margaret and I are not moving. I've also made it clear that I am always in discernment about my role in the parish. This will be ongoing. If anyone would like to discuss this with me, please do so. With a long tenure, the temptation is to coast along. I don't want us to do that. And I think you don't either.

Like last year, we will hold an "Episcopal 101" class. This class will be held in cooperation with All Saints Episcopal church. Both the rector of All Saints, Marisa Thompson, and myself, will take turns leading the class. All classes will be held at All Saints in the library. These classes will be from 6:00 PM until 7:30 PM every Wednesday evening for six weeks starting March 4<sup>th</sup> and ending April 8<sup>th</sup>. A meal will be provided as well as childcare. Look for the sign-up sheet that will soon appear as you enter the main church.

In March your vestry and staff will be meeting together in retreat to talk not only about what's worked or not worked in the past, but also to strategically plan for the future. I envision that such a plan will continue our work with the Renewal Works project we did last September. This will help us focus toward our future as followers of Jesus.

There are many other ways that we continue to move forward as a parish. Do me a favor, if you know of someone seeking a church home, invite them. If you know of someone who might benefit, invite them. I think St. Andrew's has a lot to offer and I hope you do too!

## Important information for anyone that uses the downstairs dishwasher.

### DOWNSTAIRS DISHWASHER START-UP INSTRUCTIONS

1. Take out scrap screen and scrap basket. Check bottom of wash tank for foreign objects. Then clean and put back scrap screen and scrap basket.
2. Be sure drain lever is in closed (down) position (close if necessary) and then close dishwasher doors.
3. Turn on power box on wall by pulling lever, then switch on booster heater on floor to right of dishwasher by flipping toggle switch, and finally, push button on dishwasher control box that is just below dishwasher. The dishwasher is now powered and ready to run.
4. Open dishwasher doors and then close them. The machine will start to fill with water. The control box screen will read "FILL".
5. When machine is filled with water, the control box screen will show the temperature of the wash tank water.
6. The machine is ready to wash when the temperature reaches 150 degrees or higher. This will take about 20 minutes.
7. Pre-rinse a rack of dishes with the hanging sprayer, open the dishwasher doors, and slide in the dish rack.
8. Close the dishwasher doors. The machine will carry out a wash and rinse cycle automatically. Wash cycle has soap and rinse cycle has rinse solution.
9. The machine will wash for 40 seconds (temperature must be 150 degrees or greater). The machine will then rinse for 9 seconds (temperature must be 180 degrees or greater).
10. Open doors and move rack of clean dishes to left and repeat with new rack of dishes. Rack and dishes will be hot.

### DISHWASHER TURN-OFF INSTRUCTIONS

1. When finished washing dishes, drain the water from dishwasher by pulling up the lever on the right side of the tank. **NOTE: IT IS VERY IMPORTANT TO DRAIN THE MACHINE WHILE IT IS STILL TURNED ON.**
2. Turn off dishwasher control box by pushing the black button. The screen will go blank.
3. Turn off booster heater by flipping the toggle switch.
4. Turn off main power using the lever on the grey power box on wall.
5. Using hanging sprayer, wash out inside of machine.
6. Lift out scrap basket and scrap screen, and remove all food material. Check and remove any objects from bottom of machine. Replace scrap screen and scrap basket.
7. Close drain by pushing drain lever down. It is OK to leave doors open so machine can dry out.
8. Machine is now ready for the next user.

### Extra Information

1. Be sure that there is a container to catch water in case the booster heater drains during the start up process. This occurs occasionally. The booster drainpipe is near the floor to the left of the booster heater. If it does drain, empty the container so it will not overflow if the booster heater drains again (a very rare event). Careful, the water could be hot.
2. During the startup process, it is OK to open and close the washer doors occasionally to confirm the washer is going through the wash and rinse cycles correctly. However, do not wash dishes until the wash water temperature is 150 degrees or greater, and the rinse water temperature is 180 degrees or greater.
3. Feel free to set up a time with me to go over how to use the machine prior to your event. I will meet with you and together we can turn on the machine, wash some dishes, and turn it off.
4. If questions occur when you are using the machine at your event, contact me for help.
