GRADES 5-6:

- Weaving God's Promises (Older Youth Curriculum)
- To begin to identify individual spiritual gifts and to know our church to be a safe and loving space for you and for friends to find acceptance and God's love.
- To participate in an instructed Eucharist with before-and-after questions and discussion.
- To be able to explain the broad arc of salvation history, the biblical story of God's people and the life of Jesus.
- To begin to reflect on scripture and its meaning in our lives.
- To understand the format of the lectionary and how it ties to the liturgical calendar.
- To being to reflect on and discuss moral issues from a Christian perspective, especially issues that arise from school, friends, and the conflicts, temptations, and issues common to teenagers.
- To gain a sense of responsibility for belonging to large and small communities, including the development of listening skills.
- To participate and learn, leading to a choice about Confirmation.
- To become more familiar with the Bible and The Book of Common Prayer. To learn to develop a personal prayer life.
- Faith in the world: To begin involvement in ministry and the church community: volunteering for outreach event, collecting supplies for a Magdalene House...To being to articulate stewardship of creation with time, talent, and treasure.
